The owner of this card was working with **High Pressure Water Jetting** at operating pressures up to 3000 bar (43,500 psi). The jet velocity can reach as high as 700 m/s. Not only water (drinking water quality) but also small size solids (e.g. mineral grit particles, paint or lacquer particles) could be injected. This injury must be considered to be an **urgent surgical emergency** and must be treated by a **qualified emergency medical doctor**.

**FIRST AID:**

**1** Lay up injured part of the body. **2** Cover wound sterile or dress it. In case of acute hemorrhage, fix a pressure bandage. **3** Supervise injured person permanently. **4** If part of the body is cut off, wrap it in a sterile cloth or clean plastic bag and keep it cool. **5** Transport into an emergency hospital as soon as possible.
